2019 POOL SEASON DATES AND HOURS OF OPERATION

The Pool opens at 10:00 am, Friday, May 17, 2019, and closes at 9:00 pm, Sunday, September 29, 2019.

- Lifeguards are staffed from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm

Friday (school day): 10:00 am – 9:00 pm

Saturday and Sunday: 10:00 am – 9:00 pm

- Lifeguards are staffed all day

Friday, May 24 (Last day of School) to Wednesday, July 31

The Pool is open every day 10:00 am to 9:00 pm with lifeguard staffing

Thursday, August 1 to Monday, September 2*

- Lifeguards are staffed from 4:00 pm – 7:00 pm
- ***Labor Day (Mon., Sept. 2):** 10:00 am – 9:00 pm with lifeguard staffing

- Lifeguards are staffed from 4:00 pm – 9:00 pm

Saturday and Sunday: 10:00 am – 9:00 pm

- No lifeguard coverage and Slide closed. Swim at your own risk.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

Please make sure to read the Rules before the season starts to avoid confusion about the hours of operation and the “do’s and don’ts” for the Pool Season.

In order to maintain a positive pool atmosphere and to adhere to Board of Health recommendations, the following rules and regulations have been adopted and must be adhered to by all by homeowners, residents and their guests. These pool rules are posted on the The Overlook at Marietta Country Club Homeowners Association, Inc. (“Association”) website at www.oamcc.org.

Homeowners must be in “good standing” to use/access any amenities (pool, tennis, clubhouse and family pavilion), which means *current on all fees due to the Association, including but not limited to assessments, fines and liens or other encumbrances that have been levied on the owner or property within the The Overlook at Marietta Country Club (“OAMCC”)*.

- The pool shall be limited to homeowners and a maximum of six (6) guests per family. **Homeowners must accompany their guests at all times.**
- Pool hours are posted. Entering the pool area when closed may result in card deactivation and/or fines to the homeowner’s Association account.
- There are two (2) new built-in grills (charcoal and gas) in the covered picnic area. All of the remaining old pool furniture has been replaced in this area. If you would like to use the grills, you must supply your propane tank or charcoal and clean up when you are finished. You must also check the community calendar to ensure there is not a pool party scheduled.
- Homeowners are permitted to “swim at your own risk” from 6:00 am to 8:00 am when the pool is officially closed. Please fill out the waiver and send it to GCM so your card can be activated accordingly. **To “Swim At Your Own Risk”, residents must be age 18 or older.** If under the age of 18, you must be accompanied by a homeowner, family member or caregiver over the age of 18.
- Residents must have Amenity Access Cards with them at **ALL TIMES**. No homeowners, family members or caregivers will be allowed to access the pool without the Amenity Access Card.
- There will be a **Pool Monitor** at the gate during peak and select pool hours this season. The Monitor will validate that you have a working Amenity Access Card, your last name, street address and log the number of guests enjoying the pool with you. There are a maximum of six (6) guests per day per family permitted. (A valid access card must be presented when entering the pool or if requested by Lifeguards, Pool Monitor, GCM Representative and/or OAMCC Board Member). Do not leave the gate open or propped open.
- If your Amenity Access Card is not working or lost, please contact Tara Wilkes at twilkes@gcmmgt.com. GCM will activate and mail a new Amenity Access Card to you. Replacement cards are \$25.
- Swim Atlanta is providing pool services again this year and will provide two lifeguards most days of the season (as noted above). **Once every hour, the Pool will be cleared for a 10-minute safety break and Adult Swim.** During this break, lifeguards will not be on duty.
- Parents are asked to be considerate and cognizant of their children’s behavior while at the pool. Lifeguards will be utilizing a “time-out” discipline process for inappropriate behavior. **Parents – please ensure your children, ages 6 and older, are playing safely among the toddlers and babies in the baby pool and mushroom area at all times!** Children, ages 6 and older, may play in the smaller pool and mushroom area at the discretion of the lifeguards.
- During lifeguard-monitored hours, all children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18.
- Use of the pool during closed hours may result in card deactivation and/or fines to the homeowner’s account.
- Stairs and ladders are to be used for entering and exiting the pool only. The rope is a pool divider. The stairs, ladders and rope are not to be used for play.
- Smoking, gum or use of any tobacco products, including e-cigarettes/vapes are prohibited in the pool area and bathroom area.
- Food and drinks are allowed only on the pool deck.
- No glass/glass containers are allowed anywhere in the pool area.

- All persons having any contagious disease or infectious conditions are prohibited from using the pool.
- When there is vomit or fecal matter in the pool, the pool must be shut down for 24 hours.
- Incontinent individuals are NOT permitted in adult pool and **MUST** have on rubber pants over swim diapers when using the smaller pool. Individuals who wear diapers must use the wading pool only. Failure to wear rubber pants and swimming diapers may result in card deactivation and/or fines to the homeowner's account.
- Swimsuits shall be worn in the pool. No cut-off jeans or street clothing is permitted in the pool.
- No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- Diving into the pool is prohibited.
- Damage to OAMCC property, including game tables, trees, shrubbery, furniture, etc. is prohibited and anyone responsible for such damage shall be held liable.
- The pool may be closed for maintenance, health conditions, weather or any other reason deemed necessary by lifeguards, Pool Monitors, GCM representatives and/or OAMCC Board of Directors.
- All floats and pool toys/accessories are allowed at the discretion of the lifeguard.
- Place all trash in the provided receptacles. Please do not litter in the parking lot. This is your property, take care of it and help keep it clean.
- Running and horseplay of any type are strictly prohibited.
- Lifeguards and pool monitors are the authorities in the pool area. They are there for your safety and the safety of your families, neighbors and friends. If you believe you have a problem with a lifeguard, please do not be confrontational. Contact the Board of Directors instead. Disobeying shall result in removal from the facility. Disrespecting a lifeguard or inappropriate conduct/language may result in card deactivation and/or fines to the owner's account.
- Maximum swimming pool and deck occupancy is 300.

WATER SLIDE RULES

- Only **ONE** (1) person on the slide at a time. No sitting on laps. No trains of people coming down together. This includes parents and children.
- All sliders must go down feet first and in a seated position.
- No horseplay is allowed on the slide or around the slide, whether on the slide, the stairs or otherwise.
- No stopping, climbing on or crawling up the slide at any time.
- No flotation devices are permitted on the slide.
- No running, standing, kneeling, rotating, tumbling or stopping in any flume or tunnel.
- No diving or flipping while exiting from a flume.
- Do not use slide while under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
- Do not fail to obey the instructions of the Pool Monitor or lifeguard.
- Keep your hands inside the flume while using the slide.
- Leave the falling-entry pool promptly after exiting from the slide.
- Do not possess any glass, bottle or food in or near the pool or slide.
- No entry into an area of grass or other vegetation.
- No toys or cans are permitted on the slide.
- Do not use or wear any clothing on the slide other than the usual swimwear.
